## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"SGT Alex Drabik Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate Route 475 between Hill Avenue and State Route 2, in Lucas County.
Other Information	In 1945, SGT Alex Drabik was the first Allied soldier to cross the Rhine River during World War II. He led the charge across the Remagen Bridge under heavy fire from German forces and was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for his bravery.
