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The bill specifies that a regional council of governments that is operating a self-funded health benefit program but does not act as a third-party administrator for such program is, under specified circumstances, not engaged in the business of insurance and is not subject to Ohio's insurance laws. The bill also extends the amount of time a life insurance policy may be backdated from three to six months. Other provisions in the bill are technical and corrective in nature. Please refer to the LSC bill analysis for a detailed description of the bill's changes and corrections.

The bill does not have any fiscal effects on the state or local governments.
