DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"SGT David S. Harris Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 4, between the intersection of Owens Road West and the intersection of Somerlot Hoffman Road West, in Marion County.
Other Information	SGT David S. Harris served in the Army during the Vietnam War and was killed in action on March 24, 1969.
