## Substitute Bill Comparative Synopsis

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_133_0005-4)
Historical motor vehicle	
Defines "historical motor vehicle" to include a replica vehicle and applies authorizations, procedures, and requirements applicable to historical motor vehicles to replica motor vehicles ( <i>R.C.</i> 4501.01(G), 4503.181, 4513.071, 4513.38, and 4513.41).	Instead, establishes new authorizations, procedures, and requirements that apply only to replica motor vehicles (the new authorizations, procedures, and requirements are substantively the same as the authorizations, procedures, and requirements that apply to historical vehicles) ( <i>R.C</i> 4503.183, 4513.071, 4513.38, and 4513.41).
Replica motor vehicle license plate	
Requires a person who titles their motor vehicle as a replica motor vehicle to display a historical motor vehicle license plate and applies procedures and requirements currently applicable to historical motor vehicle license plates to replica motor vehicles ( <i>R.C. 4503.181(D</i> )).	<ul> <li>Instead, requires a person who titles their motor vehicle as a replica motor vehicle to display a replica motor vehicle license plate bearing the inscription "Replica Vehicle – Ohio" along with the registration number and applies all of the requirements that apply to the historical motor vehicle license plate to the new replica motor vehicle license plate as follows:</li> <li>1. Specifies that a replica motor vehicle license plate is valid without renewal as long as the vehicle for which it was issued or procured is in existence;</li> </ul>

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_133_0005-4)
	<ol> <li>Specifies that the replica motor vehicle plate is issued for the owner's use only unless later transferred to another replica motor vehicle owned by that person;</li> </ol>
	3. Establishes procedures for transfer;
	<ol> <li>Authorizes the registrar to revoke any replica motor vehicle plate when the owner does not comply with the law governing replica motor vehicles;</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>Requires the replica motor vehicle license plate to be surrendered when revoked (R.C. 4503.183(D) and (E)).</li> </ol>
Replica motor vehicle title	
Allows the owner of the motor vehicle to request that the certificate of title indicate that the motor vehicle is a replica motor vehicle when a clerk of a court of common pleas issues a physical or electronic certificate of title, duplicate certificate of title, or memorandum certificate of title ( <i>R.C. 4505.072(B)</i> ).	Same, but allows the owner to request the replica motor vehicle indication on the original physical or electronic certificate of title <b>only</b> (R.C. 4505.072(B)).
Specifies that <i>every</i> subsequent certificate of title, memorandum certificate of title, or duplicate certificate of title must bear the replica title indication ( <i>R.C. 4505.072(C)(3)</i> ).	Authorizes subsequent owners to request that the replica motor vehicle indication be included on the title ( <i>R.C. 4505.072(D)(3)</i> ).
Fee for replica motor vehicle title	
Authorizes the registrar to establish a fee for the issuance of a replica motor vehicle title ( <i>R.C. 4505.072(C)(1)</i> ).	Instead specifies that the existing statutory fees for a motor vehicle title apply to a replica motor vehicle title ( <i>R.C. 4505.072(C)(1)</i> ).
