This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_133_1042-3)
Violent offenders subject to registration	
Adds to the classification of "violent offender" subject to continuing law violent offender database enrollment requirements a person who is convicted of permitting child abuse, domestic violence, certain endangering children offenses, or an attempt or conspiracy to commit such an offense, when the offender was 18 years old or older and the victim was under 14 years old at the time of the offense (<i>R.C. 2903.41(A)(1)(b)</i>).	Removes endangering children offenses from the classification, but otherwise retains the expanded classification (<i>R.C. 2903.41(A)(1)(b)</i>).
