# **Bill Analysis**

#### **SUMMARY**

- Allows a county to purchase public health-related items and communication equipment without competitive bidding, solicit bids electronically, and open bids during a meeting held electronically during the period of the emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 9, 2020.
- Declares an emergency.

#### **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

### County competitive bidding suspended

Ohio law generally requires counties to competitively bid a purchase over \$50,000, to notify the public regarding bid opportunities by publishing in a newspaper, and to open bids publicly at an established time and place.<sup>1</sup> The bill suspends these requirements during the period of the emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 9, 2020, but the suspension of competitive bidding for purchases over \$50,000 only applies to purchases for resources and supplies necessary to public health and communications equipment.<sup>2</sup>
