SUMMARY

- Appropriates \$10 million from GRF to the Ohio Department of Health for distribution to the Association of Community Health Centers to respond to the COVID-19 outbreak.
- Declares an emergency.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Appropriation to the Association of Community Health Centers

The bill appropriates \$10 million from GRF in fiscal year 2020 to the Ohio Department of Health for distribution to the Ohio Association of Community Health Centers to respond to the COVID-19 outbreak.¹

Emergency clause

The bill is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and therefore goes into immediate effect.² Emergency laws require a two-thirds vote of the members of each house.³ However, the bill consists entirely of an appropriation for current expense, which under the Ohio Constitution, takes effect immediately and requires only a majority vote of the members of each house.⁴
