## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

License Plate	<b>Summit Metro Parks</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the representatives of Summit Metro Parks Foundation and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution;	\$10 required contribution.	
Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.	
	Contributions must be paid to the Summit Metro Parks Foundation, which must use the contributions in support of the Summit Metro Parks. <sup>2</sup>	
Requirements for Issuance	1. Submission of an application;	
	2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and	
	3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.

Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. <sup>3</sup>
