## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

License Plate	<b>Stop Elder Abuse</b> license plate, which must display the words "Stop Elder Abuse" and any other appropriate logo or words selected by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	No required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. <sup>2</sup>
Requirements for Issuance	<ol> <li>Submission of an application;</li> <li>Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and</li> <li>Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.</li> </ol>
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
