Capital reappropriations for the FY 2021-FY 2022 biennium

The bill reappropriates approximately \$1.28 billion in capital funds for the FY 2021-FY 2022 biennium. This amount represents an estimate of available moneys on July 1, 2020. Generally, the actual reappropriations will be equal to the actual moneys available on July 1, 2020. These capital reappropriations are summarized in the two tables below. Table 1 presents the estimated amounts by fund. Table 2 presents the estimated amounts by fund and agency. The bill also amends Section 812.10 of H.B. 529 of the 132nd General Assembly (the capital appropriations and reappropriations act for the FY 2019-FY 2020 capital biennium) to clarify that, while the appropriations made in H.B. 529 end on "midnight on June 30, 2020," the ability for the Treasurer of State or Ohio Public Facilities Commission to authorize or issue debt extends beyond that time and date. Finally, the bill declares an emergency and will go into effect immediately.
