DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Ohio State Highway Patrol MCEI Kimra Skelton Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate Route 75, between the intersection of that route and State Route 41 and the intersection of that route and U.S. Route 36 in Miami County.

COMMENT

On November 27, 2019, Motor Carrier Enforcement Inspector (MCEI) Kimra J. Skelton was struck and killed by a vehicle while on duty.

MCEI Skelton joined the Ohio State Highway Patrol in 2005. In 2011, she transferred to the Piqua Driver License Examination Station as a driver license examiner 1. In 2016, she was promoted to a motor vehicle inspector and transferred to the Piqua District Commercial Enforcement Unit. In 2017, she was promoted to a motor carrier enforcement inspector.
