DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Sergeant Frederick A. Raby Highway." ¹
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of I-90, between mile marker 69 and mile marker 71, in Wood County.
Other Information	Sergeant Frederick A. Raby was a state highway patrol officer who was struck by a motor vehicle while conducting a routine traffic stop on September 1, 1990. The force of the strike left Sergeant Raby critically injured with traumatic head and body injuries, from which he has never fully recovered.
