Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments

H.B. 11 of the 133rd General Assembly

Senate Health, Human Services and Medicaid

Prenatal dental program

Permits (rather than requires) the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) to establish and administer a prenatal dental program for pregnant Medicaid recipients.

Appropriations

Eliminates proposed funding of \$2.5 million in both FY 2020 and FY 2021 in GRF appropriation item 651531, Oral Healthcare (within ODM's budget), for the prenatal dental program.

Eliminates proposed funding of \$3.5 million in FY 2020 in GRF appropriation item 440474, Infant Vitality (within the Ohio Department of Health's budget), for planning and group prenatal health care services grants; instead, increases the same line item to \$5.0 million in FY 2021 (from \$2.5 million) and specifies that \$500,000 must be used for planning grants and \$4.5 million must be used for the group prenatal health services grants.

Conforming change

As a result of recent enactments, replaces an outdated section of the bill with the updated version and removes a section containing definitions that recently enacted law already reflects.
