S.B. 10 of the 133rd General Assembly

Personal jurisdiction

 Expands the basis of a court's exercise of personal jurisdiction to include any basis consistent with the Ohio Constitution and the U.S. Constitution.

Tolling of statutes of limitation and other time limitations

- Specifies that the time period between March 9, 2020, and July 30, 2020, cannot be computed as part of criminal statutes of limitations, the civil statutes of limitations, and the administrative statutes of limitations and any other criminal, civil, or administrative time limitations;
- Specifies that the period of limitation and time limitation provisions expire on July 30, 2020, rather than when the period of emergency ends or July 30, 2020, whichever is sooner, as provided for in H.B. 197 of the 133rd General Assembly.

Emergency clause

 Declares an emergency, but maintains a 90-day effective date for provisions in the bill other than the periods of limitation and time limitation provisions discussed immediately above.
