Synopsis of Senate Floor Amendments

H.B. 160 of the 133rd General Assembly

Agency store sales of alcohol

Reduces from 14,000 square feet (as established in the bill) to 10,000 square feet the minimum square footage an agency store must have to be issued a D-3 liquor permit to sell spirituous liquor by the drink for on-premises consumption.

Surgeon General's warning

Prohibits an A-5 permit holder from manufacturing ice cream that contains alcohol unless the label for the ice cream includes the Surgeon General's warning specified under federal law regarding consuming alcohol while pregnant or operating a motor vehicle.

Specifies that the prohibition only applies to ice cream that is sold at a grocery store or convenience store.
