DETAILED ANALYSIS

License Plate	Summit Metro Parks license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the representatives of Summit Metro Parks Foundation and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. ¹	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	\$10 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. Contributions must be paid to the Summit Metro Parks Foundation, which must use the contributions in support of the Summit Metro Parks. ²	
Requirements for Issuance	 Submission of an application; Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
