DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

| Designated Name | "Deputy Sheriff Emil Kleinwaechter Memorial Highway" ¹ |
|-------------------|---|
| Highway | The portion of U.S. Route 50 running in an easterly and westerly direction between Newtown Road and Elm Road, in Hamilton County. |
| Other Information | Deputy Emil Kleinwaechter was killed in the line of duty on July 16, 1962. While responding to a traffic accident, he was struck by a motor vehicle travelling at a high rate of speed that crossed over the centerline. He served with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office for 13 years. |
