SUMMARY

- Prohibits state institutions of higher education from requiring any student to live in on-campus housing, for the 2020-2021 school year only.
- Declares an emergency.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

University on-campus student housing requirements

The bill prohibits state institutions of higher education from requiring any student to live in on-campus housing, for the 2020-2021 school year only, regardless of the distance that the student resides from campus.¹ State institutions of higher education include state universities, the Northeast Ohio Medical University, community colleges, state community colleges, university branch campuses, and technical colleges.²

Under current law, state universities cannot require a student to live in on-campus housing if the student resides within 25 miles of the campus. However, students who live beyond that distance may be required by a state university to live in on-campus housing.³
