DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the bridge and its approaches indicating its name:

| Designated Name | "SGT Gary Lee McKiddy Memorial Highway" ¹ |
|-------------------|--|
| Highway | The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 725, between South Union Road and Soldiers Home Road, in Montgomery County. |
| Other Information | Sergeant Gary Lee McKiddy, 20 years old, was killed on May 6, 1970, in the line of duty while serving in the Vietnam War. He was posthumously awarded the Silver Star for his actions. |
