This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_133_0259-2)
Second Chance Fund	
Requires the Registrar of Motor Vehicles and each deputy registrar to ask a person renewing a motor vehicle registration for a \$1 voluntary contribution to support organ donation programs (<i>R.C. 4503.027(A)(4)</i>).	No provision.
Maintains current law that requires the Registrar and each deputy registrar to ask a person applying for or renewing a driver's license, commercial driver's license, state identification card, or duplicate thereof for a \$1 voluntary contribution to support organ donation programs (<i>R.C. 4503.027(A</i>)).	Increases the donation request to \$2 (<i>R.C. 4503.027(A)</i>).

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_133_0259-2)
Organ donation request at the time of registration	
No provision.	Authorizes a person to make an anatomical gift by specifying during either a motor vehicle registration application or renewal that the person wishes to make that anatomical gift (<i>R.C. 2108.05(A)(2) and 4503.10(A)(8)</i>).
No provision.	Specifies that a person who certifies his or her willingness to make an anatomical gift during motor vehicle registration does not need to recertify that willingness on renewal of the registration (<i>R.C. 2108.05(C</i>)).
No provision.	Requires the Registrar to add a person who certifies a willingness to make an anatomical gift at the time of motor vehicle registration in the donor registry developed and maintained by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (<i>R.C. 2108.23(A)(1)</i>).
No provision.	Requires the Registrar and any deputy registrar to ask a person applying for or renewing a motor vehicle registration whether the person wishes to certify a willingness to make an anatomical gift, unless the person has certified that willingness previously. (Current law requires the Registrar and deputy registrars to ask the same question when a person applies for or renews a driver's license, commercial driver's license, state identification card, or duplicate thereof.) (<i>R.C.</i> 2108.23(A)(2) and (5) and 4503.10(A)(8)).
No provision.	Requires the Registrar to adopt rules regarding the manner in which a person may apply to be included in the donor registry (either through questions on the BMV application or a through a link specific to the registry). (R.C. 2108.23(C)(1)(f)).

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_133_0259-2)
"Donate Life" license plate	
No provision.	Increases the required annual contribution for the "Donate Life" license plate from \$5 to \$15 (<i>R.C. 4503.721</i>).
