## DETAILED ANALYSIS

Designation	Sanfilippo Syndrome Awareness Day
Date	November 16
Other Information	Sanfilippo Syndrome (also known as MPS III) is a rare, progressive, and fatal genetic disease affecting 1 in 70,000 children. It affects the metabolism of complex molecules and results in severe damage to the entire body, but most significantly to the brain. The symptoms have been described as comparable to Alzheimer's disease, except in children. <sup>1</sup>
