SUMMARY

• Authorizes podiatrists to administer influenza vaccinations to individuals seven or older.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Podiatrist administration of flu shots

The act authorizes podiatrists to administer influenza vaccinations to individuals seven or older.¹ While it permits a podiatrist to engage in this additional activity, the act retains the law defining the practice of podiatric medicine and surgery as the treatment of any of the following: foot ailments; muscles and tendons of the leg that govern functions of the foot; and superficial hand lesions not associated with trauma.²
