DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the bridge and its approaches indicating its name:

Designated Name	"SSG Garren Ray Goudy Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 7, between the northern border of the municipal corporation of Powhatan Point and Pipe Creek Road, in Belmont County.
Other Information	Staff Sergeant Garren Ray Goudy, 28 years old, was killed in action on November 22, 1968, while serving in the Vietnam War. He was awarded the Silver Star with four oak leaf clusters.
