The bill results in no direct fiscal effect to the state or political subdivisions. The bill makes several changes to the law governing the responsibilities and activities regarding two voluntary private residential communities: (1) condominium unit owners associations and (2) planned community home owners associations. The bill also revises the definition of "developer" for the purposes of the New Community Law (Chapter 349 of the Revised Code) to allow one private community (Lakeside Chautauqua) to qualify as a New Community Authority, as governed under Chapter 349 of the Revised Code.
