# **Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments**

### **Political Subdivision Tort Liability Law**

#### Defense to a political subdivision's liability

Removes a defense to a political subdivision's liability if a peace officer of a political subdivision negligently operated a motor vehicle and the plaintiff was attempting to flee to avoid apprehension for a criminal offense.

#### **Definition of emergency call**

Modifies the definition of emergency call to mean a communication from a citizen, a police dispatch, other peace officers, or personal observation and knowledge by a peace officer only if that communication, dispatch, or observation or knowledge involves or concerns an inherently dangerous situation that demands an immediate response from a peace officer.

### **Recoverable damages**

Modifies the recoverable damages against a political subdivision to specify that any compensatory damages recoverable against a political subdivision for a peace officer's, fire fighter's, or emergency medical technician's operation of a motor vehicle must be reduced by the percentage of contributory fault attributed to the plaintiff or any other parties, subject to specified laws.
