SUMMARY

Authorizes a property tax exemption for certain privately owned wetlands.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Private wetlands exemption

The bill authorizes a property tax exemption for certain privately owned wetlands. To qualify, the property must be owned or held by a 501(c)(3) organization that is dedicated to the conservation of natural resources or improving water quality. Additionally, the property must be subject to a federal or state environmental response plan for wetland conservation or mitigation.¹

The exemption applies to tax years ending on or after the provision's effective date.²
