## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"SGT Joseph P. Collette Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 158, between Ginder Rd. NW and Carroll Eastern Rd. NW, in Fairfield County.
Other Information	Sergeant Joseph P. Collette died from wounds sustained in combat operations in Afghanistan on March 22, 2019. He earned, among other awards and decorations, the Purple Heart, the Combat Action Badge, and the Senior Explosive Ordnance Disposal Badge.
