DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"U.S. Army Specialist Christian D. Ward Memorial Highway"
Highway	A portion of State Route (SR) 60, running in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction, between the intersection of SR 60 and County Road 121 and the intersection of SR 60 and County Road 87, in Washington County.
Other Information	U.S. Army Specialist Christian Ward joined the Army in 2015 and was stationed in Fort Carson, Colorado. While in the Army, he earned the Army Commendation Medal, National Defense Service Medal, and the Aviation Badge. Specialist Ward was killed in a motorcycle accident on June 28, 2019, in Colorado Springs, Colorado.
