## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Steven Lowell Cook Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 800, between Ross Kennon Road and Shannon Road, in Belmont County.
Other Information	Steven Lowell Cook was a Barnesville construction worker who was struck and killed by a driver on September 30, 2017, while working in a construction zone on I-70. He previously worked for R&F Coal Company and R&R Trucking.
