DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Deputy Sheriff Emil Kleinwaechter Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	United States Route (US) 50, running in a westerly and easterly direction, commencing at the intersection of US 50 and Newtown Road and extending to the intersection of US 50 and Elm Road, in Hamilton County
Other Information	Deputy Kleinwaechter was a U.S. Army veteran and served with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office for 13 years. He was struck and killed by a vehicle while directing traffic around the scene of a serious accident on Wooster Pike, east of Newtown Road on July 16, 1962.
