DETAILED ANALYSIS

License Plate	Circleville Pumpkin Show license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the representatives of the Circleville Pumpkin Show, Inc., and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. ¹	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	\$25 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. Contributions must be paid to the Circleville Pumpkin Show, Inc., which must use the contributions to promote good will surrounding the Circleville Pumpkin Show as a nonprofit annual event. ²	
Requirements for Issuance	 Submission of an application; Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and

	3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
