## **Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments**

## Sub. H.B. 67 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly Senate Primary & Secondary Education

As Passed by the House	As Reported by S. Primary & Secondary Education
Qualifications for a high school diploma	
For the 2020-2021 through 2023-2024 school years, permits a student to use the final course grade in a course associated with an end-of-course examination in lieu of a score on that examination to satisfy conditions for a high school diploma (R.C. 3313.6120).	For the 2020-2021 school year, permits a student who is in the eleventh or twelfth grade who takes or retakes an end-of-course examination or who is unable to take or retake an end-of-course examination for any reason in that school year to use the student's final course grade in lieu of an examination score to satisfy conditions for a high school diploma (Section 9).
No provision.	For the 2020-2021 school year only, permits a student to qualify for a high school diploma by satisfying both of the following conditions:
	(1) Successfully complete curriculum requirements as otherwise required under continuing law; and
	(2) Earn the OhioMeansJobs-readiness Seal. (Section 10).
Community school sponsor ratings	
No provision.	For the 2020-2021 school year, prohibits the Department of Education from issuing a rating to a community school sponsor for the academic performance component, as otherwise required under current law. Also prohibits the Department from including academic performance in the calculation of an overall rating for a sponsor

	(Section 6(D) of H.B. 409 of the 133 <sup>rd</sup> General Assembly, amended by Section 1 of the bill).
	Requires that a sponsor's rating for the 2020-2021 school year be based on only the adherence to quality practices and compliance with laws and rules components as required under continuing law (Section 6(D) of H.B. 409 of the 133 <sup>rd</sup> General Assembly, amended by Section 1 of the bill).
	States that a sponsor's rating for the 2020-2021 school year does not qualify the sponsor for any incentive for which the sponsor was not previously eligible prior to receiving that rating (Section 6(D) of H.B. 409 of the 133 <sup>rd</sup> General Assembly, amended by Section 1 of the bill).
Emergency clause	
No provision.	Declares an emergency (Section 11).
