### Substance abuse civil commitment

The committee accepted an amendment to the bill that eliminates a provision of current law that authorizes a court to order the hospitalization on an immediate, emergency basis (i.e., under a 72-hour hold) of a respondent who is found by clear and convincing evidence after a hearing to present an imminent danger or imminent threat of danger to self, family, or others as a result of alcohol or other drug abuse.
