## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

License plate	<b>Marshall University</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by representatives of Marshall University (in West Virginia) and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	<ul> <li>\$30 required contribution.</li> <li>\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.</li> <li>Contributions must be paid to Marshall University for the purpose of awarding grants or scholarships to Ohio residents who attend the University.<sup>2</sup></li> </ul>	
Requirements for Issuance	<ol> <li>Submission of an application;</li> <li>Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and</li> <li>Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.</li> </ol>

Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided for in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. <sup>3</sup>
