SUMMARY

- Makes an appropriation of \$465 million in FY 2021 to the Development Services Agency to fund an emergency rental assistance program.
- Makes an appropriation of \$100 million in FY 2021 to the Department of Public Safety for COVID relief.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Appropriation to provide rent and utility assistance

The bill appropriates \$465 million in FY 2021 to the Development Services Agency to fund an emergency rental assistance program in accordance with the federal "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021" and program guidelines for the use of the funds provided by the U.S. Department of the Treasury.¹

Appropriation for COVID relief

The bill makes an appropriation of \$100 million in FY 2021 to the Department of Public Safety for COVID relief.²
