SUMMARY

Permits a mayor of an Ohio municipal corporation to solemnize marriages anywhere within Ohio, rather than, as in current law, only in a county where the mayor's municipal corporation wholly or partly lies.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill permits a mayor of an Ohio municipal corporation to solemnize the marriage of any persons, not otherwise prohibited by law from being joined in marriage, anywhere in Ohio. Under current law, a mayor of an Ohio municipal corporation is permitted to solemnize a marriage in any county in which the municipal corporation wholly or partly lies.¹
