## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Officer Ciera N. Greene Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The portion of State Route 123, running in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction, between the intersection of that route with I-71 and the eastern border of the municipal corporation of Lebanon, in Warren County.
Other Information	Officer Ciera N. Greene was a Warren County corrections officer who died on November 15, 2014, after her car ran off the road and hit a utility pole. The cause of the accident is unknown.
