# **Synopsis of House Committee Amendments**

# S.B. 4 of the 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly

### **House Civil Justice**

### Mental health care providers and protective services workers

Adds forensic mental health providers, mental health evaluation providers, and regional psychiatric hospital employees to the list of professions, consolidated in continuing law into the term "designated public service worker," whose residential and familial information is exempted from disclosure under the Public Records Law.

Adds protective services workers to the list of professions whose residential and familial information is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Law. Under the bill, "protective services worker" means any employee of a county agency who is responsible for child protective services, child support services, or adult protective services.
