## SUMMARY

- Appropriates \$465 million in FY 2021 to the Development Services Agency to fund an emergency rental assistance program.
- Appropriates \$100 million to the Department of Public Safety for COVID-19 relief purposes.

## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

### Appropriation to provide rent and utility assistance

The bill appropriates \$465 million in FY 2021 to the Development Services Agency to fund an emergency rental assistance program in accordance with the federal "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021" and program guidelines for the use of the funds provided by the U.S. Department of the Treasury.<sup>1</sup>

### **Department of Public Safety appropriation**

The bill also appropriates \$100 million in FY 2021 to the Department of Public Safety, to the COVID Relief – Federal line item.
