## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Crooksville Firefighters David Theisen and Stephen Carletti Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 93, between Ceramic Way and West Main Street, in Perry County.
Other Information	Firefighters David Theisen and Stephen Carletti died in the line of duty on February 5, 1998. Both men were trapped in the basement of a house where they were attempting to put out a fire. Firefighter Theisen died of asphyxiation and burns and Firefighter Carletti died of a crushing injury.
