SUMMARY

Requires the Ohio History Connection to designate Poindexter Village as a state historic site by identifying the buildings at 290 North Champion Avenue, Columbus, as the Poindexter Village Historic Site.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill requires the Ohio History Connection to designate Poindexter Village as a state historic site by identifying the buildings at 290 North Champion Avenue, Columbus, as the Poindexter Village Historic Site. The Ohio History Connection must mark the site in accordance with the marking system established for designated historic sites within Ohio.

As specified in the bill, Poindexter Village is one of the first housing projects in America, developed in 1940, and named after the Reverend James P. Poindexter. Poindexter Village represents the birth and history of public housing in America and reflects Ohio's place in the national story of the Great Migration.¹
