This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_134_0504-1)
Nationally standardized college admissions assessments	
Eliminates the requirement that high school students take a nationally standardized college admission assessment for graduation and, instead, specifies that the assessment be offered to all 11^{th} grade students but participation is voluntary (R.C. $3301.0712(B)(1)(b)$).	Retains the requirement that high school students take a nationally standardized college admission assessment, but permits the parent or guardian of a student to opt the student out of taking the assessment (R.C. 3301.0712(B)(1)(b)).
