### DETAILED ANALYSIS

<b>License Plate</b>	<b>On Our Sleeves</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by representatives of Nationwide Children’s Hospital and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>
<b>Recipients</b>	Available to all applicants.
<b>Eligible Vehicles</b>	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
<b>Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution</b>	\$20 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. Contributions must be paid to Nationwide Children’s Hospital to use for the “On Our Sleeves” campaign. <sup>2</sup>
<b>Requirements for Issuance</b>	1. Submission of an application; 2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and 3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle
