## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following bridge and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the bridge indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Air Force 2 <sup>nd</sup> Lt. William Vaughan Memorial Bridge" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The bridge spanning I-80, located in Mahoning County and being a part of the highway known as SR 46.
Other Information	William Vaughan was a radio operator of a volunteer bomber crew which undertook an important and dangerous photo-mapping mission over the heavily defended enemy Buka airfield on the island of Bougainville during WWII. He was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for extraordinary heroism in action on this mission.
