SUMMARY

- Requires a single, separately metered, noncommercial structure on a retail electric customer's property be charged for electric service at the same rate as the customer's primary residence.
- Directs the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) to adopt rules to implement the bill.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Separately metered structure rate

This bill requires a single, separately metered, noncommercial structure on a retail electric customer's property be charged for electricity at the same rate as the customer's primary residence.¹

Additionally, PUCO must adopt rules to implement the bill. PUCO is specifically directed to include rules for inspecting an electricity customer's property to make sure that the separate structure is not being used for a commercial purpose.²
