This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Passed by the House)	Latest Version (I_134_0089-3)
Athletic trainer collaboration agreement – administering drugs	
Authorizes an athletic trainer that has entered into a collaboration agreement with one or more physicians to administer drugs that have been prescribed by a licensed health professional and administered under the direction of the prescriber (R.C. 4755.621(C)(5)).	Same, but includes an exception that prohibits an athletic trainer from administering intra-articular and intratendinous injections (R.C. 4755.621(C)(5)).
LSC technical changes	
No provision.	Makes technical updates by removing versions of R.C. 4731.22, 4755.62, and 4755.64 that are in effect until October 9, 2021, and replaces them with versions of the sections that take effect on October 9, 2021 (R.C. 4731.22, 4755.62, and 4755.64).
