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## **Highlights**

Any fiscal impacts will depend on the details of any future federal voluntary unemployment programs and whether or not the General Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution impacting Ohio's participation.

## **Detailed Analysis**

The bill prohibits the Governor or Director of Job and Family Services from entering into an agreement or issuing a special or standing order to implement new voluntary programs created under federal law providing for unemployment compensation, assistance, or allowances under certain circumstances. If the Governor or Director of Job and Family Services wishes to enter into such an agreement or issue an order to implement such a program, the Governor or Director must submit a request to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate. The General Assembly may authorize the Governor or Director to enter into an agreement or issue the order by adopting a concurrent resolution. The bill additionally allows the General Assembly to rescind the agreement or order, in whole or in part, by adopting a concurrent resolution. Any fiscal effects of the bill will depend on the details of any future federal voluntary unemployment programs and whether or not the General Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution impacting Ohio's participation.

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
