## **Synopsis of House Committee Amendments**

## S.B. 59 of the 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly

## **House Armed Services and Veterans Affairs**

Specifies that, in order to be a violation of the "Ohio Veterans' Heritage Protection Act," a person must have knowingly violated a provision of the law.

Specifies that a "war relic" also includes a statue, monument, memorial, or plaque that has been erected for, or named or dedicated in honor of, an individual's or group of individuals' service with forces of the American colonies, the U.S. federal government, or by any state in support of the U.S.

Requires money paid to the Ohio History Connection, resulting from a violation of the "Ohio Veterans' Heritage Protection Act," to be expended only for the preservation of war relics.
