## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highways indicating their names:

Designated Names	"Sgt. Cameron H. Thomas Memorial Way" <sup>1</sup>	"Sgt. Kevin J. Lannon Memorial Way" <sup>2</sup>
Highways	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route (SR) 48, between the intersections of Stroop Road and David Road, in Montgomery County.	The northbound and southbound lanes of SR 48, between the intersections of David Road and Rahn Road, in Montgomery County.
Other Information	Sgt. Cameron H. Thomas was killed in action on April 27, 2017, in Afghanistan, as a result of small arms fire during combat operations as part of Operation Freedom's Sentinel.	Sgt. Kevin J. Lannon was killed in action on October 25, 1983, in Grenada, during Operation Urgent Fury, which was conducted to protect American citizens living in the country.
