Highlights

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur costs of approximately \$500 to produce and install the memorial signs for the designated portion of State Route 87.

Detailed Analysis

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur approximately \$500 in costs for producing and installing memorial signs for the designated portion of highway. Specifically, the bill designates the portion of State Route 87 between its intersections with State Route 44 and Sperry Road within Geauga County as the Dr. Steven Takacs Memorial Highway.

If a memorial marker is to be located on a road outside of municipal boundaries, ODOT produces and installs the signs. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
